Patient safety Program Reports

The department of Dentistry conducted patient safety program on 22/09/2023. The patients in the OPD were told about safety measures taken before, during and after dental procedures, about the benefits of it and harms if precautionary measures are not taken. Some salient points explained to patients were:-

- patient safety measures are done to prevent unintentional harm to patients during medical and surgical treatments.
- all the relevant case history, past medical history and drug history are taken is before any dental procedures.
- Screening of HIV, HbsAg, HCV is done before dental procedure.
- During the procedure aseptic precautions like draping and head cap are done
- Sterilized instruments are used to prevent post operative infection.
- Post operative instructions are given to the patients in their own language.
- Faculty hold regular meetings & discussions about the accidents and errors occurred during procedures and also how to prevent them.
